# FAMILY REUNIFICATION REQUIRED DOCUMENTS – 1<sup>ST</sup> stage (VERIFICATION OF FAMILY RELATIONSHIP – "OPINION")

### A. SPOUSE

- 1. **Application form for verification of family relationship**, fully filled in and signed by the applicant
- 2. **One recent passport-size photograph** in color with white background, according to the relevant specifications laid down by ICAO
- 3. **All passports** (current and, if applicable, previous)
- 4. Marriage certificate, recent and duly attested \*
- 5. Proof of marriage
- 6. Photocopy of all **sponsor's passports** (current and, if applicable, previous all pages)
- 7. **Proof of money transfers** from the sponsor to the applicant (if applicable)
- 8. Supplementary documents (if applicable):
  - Rent agreement or proof of residence in Greece
  - Employment contract or any other proof of sponsor's employment
  - Prior approval from the Greek Authorities (request for the Consulate's opinion)

#### **B. CHILDREN**

- 1. **Application form for verification of family relationship**, fully filled in and signed by the applicant's parents
- 2. **One recent passport-size photograph** in color with white background, according to the relevant specifications laid down by ICAO
- 3. All passports (current and, if applicable, previous)
- 4. Birth certificate duly attested \*
- 5. **Supplementary documents for children applying separately** (usually in cases where both parents are already in Greece):
  - Photocopy of all father's passports (current and, if applicable, previous all pages)
  - Photocopy of all mother's passports (current and, if applicable, previous all pages)
- 6. Supplementary documents in case the sponsor or his/ her spouse has been attributed the custody of the child
  - Official proof of custody attribution, duly attested \*

## **NOTE:**

- 1) Original documents and passports submitted must be accompanied along with a copy
- 2) All documents submitted, if not in Greek or Russian, should be accompanied by a translation in those languages
- 3) The applicant may be asked for additional documents
- \* All official documents concerning the family(marital) status of citizens of Uzbekistan (certificates, birth certificates, marriage certificates, marital status certificates, etc.) applying for D Visa for family reunification purpose with Greek citizens or other holders of a residence permit in Greece or applicants moving under Directive 2004/38 / EC as family members of an EU citizen, need to be certified by Notary Public, the Ministry of Justice and the Foreign Ministry of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

# FAMILY REUNIFICATION REQUIRED DOCUMENTS – 2<sup>nd</sup> stage (DECISION - VISA)

APPLICANTS ALREADY INTERVIEWED BY THE EMBASSY AT THE 1<sup>ST</sup> STAGE SUBMIT ONLY DOCUMENTS no 1-5. FOR CASES NOT EXAMINED AT THE 1<sup>ST</sup> STAGE, ALL BELOW MENTIONED DOCUMENTS ARE SUBMITTED.

- 1. Application form for a visa for a long stay in Greece, fully filled in and signed by the applicant
- 2. One recent passport-size photograph in color with white background, according to the relevant specifications laid down by ICAO
- 3. All passports (current and, if applicable, previous). The current passport must:
  - be of a validity exceeding by 3 months the ending date of the visa length
  - include at least two blank pages
  - have been issued within the previous ten years
- 4. Police clearance Certificate, recent and duly attested \* (not required for minors under 12 years old)

### A. SPOUSE

- 1. Marriage certificate, recent and duly attested \*
- 2. Proof of marriage
- 3. Photocopy of all **sponsor's passports** (current and, if applicable, previous all pages)
- 4. **Proof of money transfers** from the sponsor to the applicant (if applicable)
- 5. **Supplementary documents** (if applicable):
  - Rent agreement or proof of residence in Greece
  - Employment contract or any other proof of sponsor's employment
  - Prior approval from the Greek Authorities (request for the Consulate's opinion)

### **B. CHILDREN**

- 1. Birth certificate duly attested \*
- 2. **Supplementary documents for children applying separately** (usually in cases where both parents are already in Greece):
  - a. Photocopy of all father's passports (current and, if applicable, previous all pages)
  - b. Photocopy of all mother's passports (current and, if applicable, previous all pages)
- 3. Supplementary documents in case the sponsor or his/ her spouse has been attributed the custody of the child
  - a. Official proof of custody attribution, duly attested \*

### NOTE:

- 1) Original documents and passports submitted must be accompanied along with a copy
- 2) All documents submitted, if not in Greek or Russian, should be accompanied by a translation in those languages
- 3) The applicant may be asked for additional documents
- 4) The visa fee is not refunded if the visa is refused
- \* All official documents concerning the family(marital) status of citizens of Uzbekistan (certificates, birth certificates, marriage certificates, marital status certificates, etc.) applying for D Visa for family reunification purpose with Greek citizens or other holders of a residence permit in Greece or applicants moving under Directive 2004/38 / EC as family members of an EU citizen, need to be certified by Notary Public, the Ministry of Justice and the Foreign Ministry of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
